



## Now is the time to act!

### Major Muslim terrorist incidents in Europe:

Istanbul, November 2003 (two attacks) 47 killed (Al Qaeda)

Madrid, March 2004: 191 killed, 1,800 injured (Al Qaeda?)

London, July 2005: 52 killed, 700 injured (Al Qaeda)

Toulouse, March 2012: 7 killed (Al Qaeda)

Brussels, May 2014: 4 killed at Jewish Museum (ISIS)

Paris, January 2015: 11 killed at Charlie Hebdo office (Al Qaeda)

Paris, November 2015: 130 killed, hundreds wounded (ISIS)

Brussels, March 2016: 34 killed, 150 injured (ISIS)

The number is multiplied many times when we include incidents in the US, at beach resorts, in Indonesia, in Africa, in Pakistan, India and the Middle East and elsewhere.

On top of terrorism, we in Britain are experiencing Muslim grooming/rape gangs, Muslim corruption of established institutions (schools, local government, free speech, the media, community cohesion), and the corrosive spread of political correctness at a time when clear language is essential to drive decisive action. We look on with trepidation at the Muslim influx overwhelming Europe - its people and civilisation.
